# Washington Update: Looking Forward to Energy and Climate Change Policies in 2014

Now that 2013 has come and gone, and with the start of the second session of the 113th Congress on January 6, climate change policies are prepared to reenter the national debate in 2014 as significant features of President Obama's climate plan are executed. In June 2014, the Environmental Protection Agency is expected to announce a historic rule aimed at reducing CO2 emissions from the nation's power plants, but not before Congress and industry groups debate the issue for several months. Another regulation from the EPA will garner additional attention as the Supreme Court will hear in February a limited challenge to the agency's authority to regulate greenhouse gas

emissions. While the court heard arguments in a challenge to the Cross-State Air Pollution Rule in December, rulings on both cases will come by June.

The Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee, currently preparing for a committee leadership shuffle, has listed its top priorities for the first part of the year as a markup of a bipartisan nuclear waste bill and readdressing an amended energy-efficiency bill from Senators Jeanne Shaheen (D-NH) and Rob Portman (R-OH).

Debates over tax reform, whether comprehensive or not, will score additional time in Congress, as will several energy-specific tax pieces, such as the now-expired Production Tax Credit and several other tax extenders pieces.

With respect to nominations, President Obama will have to start fresh on filling open positions across the agencies, including at the Environmental Protection Agency, the US Chemical Safety and Hazard Investigation Board, and the Interior Department.
