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COVID Impact on Pharmacy Practice

- Retail Pharmacies saw increased revenue/growth in 2021
 - Increased demand for and utilization of pharmacy services
 - COVID vaccinations
 - Purchase of COVID tests in-store and at-home
 - o Increase in prescriptions filled from 2020, as patients went back to their doctors
- Scope of practice of pharmacists and pharmacy technicians expanded
 - Technicians started providing vaccinations
 - Technician as a career?
 - Pharmacists obtaining independent prescribing authority for select drugs

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
Pharmacists as a Provider – Opportunities?

- COVID Expanded the Role of Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians.
 - Is there an opportunity for Pharmacists' role to further expand and to bill as a provider?
 - Chronic care management
 - Medication Therapy Management
 - Annual Wellness Visits
 - Diagnosis and prescribe treatments for flu, rashes, UTIs
 - Prescribing authority
 - Oncology Care
 - o Digital Health





COVID Impact on Independent Pharmacies



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Will COVID continue to provide opportunities for revenue/growth?

- Retail pharmacies likely to see a reduction in COVID vaccinations and, potentially, testing
- Challenges of pharmacy work conditions and pharmacist burnout
- Patients now expect more digital capabilities and conveniences from pharmacies (e.g., higher use of apps, telehealth)
- New "Disrupter" and alternative model pharmacies are entering the market





Retail Pharmacies are Shifting to In-Store Healthcare Offerings







CVS to Close 900 Stores Over Three Years

Pharmacy chain says it will add health services to other locations, book roughly \$1 billion restructuring charge







Retail Pharmacies Look to Expand Scope of Health Care Services

- Major chain pharmacies looked to expand beyond dispensing:
 - Walgreens Boots Alliance acquired majority stakes in VillageMD and CareCentrix focused on primary care and home health care
 - Walgreens HealthCorner providing in-store physician consultations
 - CVS focus on Health Hubs
 - CVS HealthHubs providing Yoga
 - CVS entered into a collaboration with Medable to deliver phase 3 and 4 clinical trials at select MinuteClinics







Consumer Focused Offerings, Convenience, and Competition


- Pharmacy mobile apps have become more important for retail pharmacies as consumers demand the convenience and access
 - Increases efficiency for both the pharmacy and the consumer
 - Increases patient adherence to prescriptions
 - Increases automation for pharmacies
- Expanded use of data to personalize interactions
- Outside of the retail space: BestBuy acquired Current Health, which provides a remote patient monitoring technology platform



Uber expands options for prescription delivery with ScriptDrop








Traditional Life-Cycle of a Prescription




Digital Health Providers are Targeting Every Step of the Prescription Life-Cycle

Regulatory Challenges for Digital Health Providers and Digital Pharmacies

- Corporate Practice of Medicine Laws
 - Which states will require the use of an Affiliated Professional Corporation ("PC")?
 - Can that PC foreign qualify in other states?
 - Does the Friendly-Physician need to be licensed in the state?
 - If Nurse Practitioners will be prescribing, what are the state supervision requirements?
- Anti-Kickback Statute
 - If the Telehealth Provider and Pharmacy will bill federal healthcare payors, is there a way to ensure compliance with the Anti-Kickback Statute?
- State Pharmacy Law
 - Are any of the owners of the pharmacy physicians? What percentage do they own?



LegitScript and NABP Certification

- LegitScript Certification or NABP's Digital Pharmacy Accreditation is required for digital pharmacies to advertise on Google and work with major banks/credit card companies
- Involves an in-depth review of the Company's registration and compliance, internal policies, and external practices, including a close look at the Company's affiliates.





Enforcement of Telemedicine Provider

- Traditional fraud schemes involving telehealth
 - Ordering of medically unnecessary products or services in connection with a sham telemedicine consult (and sometimes no consult at all)
 - Pursued by multiple state and federal agencies (DOJ, CMS, HHS OIG, state medical boards, etc.)
 - Typically involve multiple criminal prosecutions of health care professionals, telemedicine executives, and other individuals



Telemedicine Executives

They own telemedicine companies and call centers. They use international marketing networks to lure unsuspecting individuals into a criminal scheme through telemarketing calls, direct mail, television ads, and internet pop-up ads. A call center confirms that an individual is on Medicare or Medicaid and transfers the individual to a telemedicine company for a medical practitioner's consultation. Telemedicine executives are the masterminds of this scheme. They pay practitioners for prescriptions.



Medical Practitioner & Telemedicine Company

The telemedicine company obtains prescriptions from medical practitioners and sells them to pharmacies, laboratories, or medical equipment companies. Medical practitioners are being paid by telemedicine executives to order unnecessary prescriptions, either without any patient interaction or with only a brief telephonic conversation with patients they have never met or seen.

Pharmacy, Lab, Medical Equipment Company

Aft pre Me fro bill

After the pharmacy, lab, or medical equipment company purchases the prescription, it sends the prescription to the beneficiary. Medicare or Medicaid is then billed and the telemedicine executives receive a kickback from the scam. This telemedicine fraud scheme has caused more than \$4.5 billion in loss and the revoking of Medicare and Medicaid billing privileges of over 250 medical professionals.
