

Summary of Health Care Related Provisions in February 5th Continuing Resolution

Late Monday night (February 5, 2018), the House of Representatives released a <u>continuing resolution</u> to keep the government funded and running until March 23, 2018. This CR includes many health care related provisions, specifically many of the health care "minibus" riders. The following chart summarizes major health care provisions in this CR specific to the health care minibus. Note the entire CHRONIC Care Act is included in this CR. (Other health care related provisions are included in the CR, but may not be detailed in this chart.)
